Cemetery projects are on hold. Central Park- there is a possibly empty wasp nest on the library side basketball hoop. Fence needs replaced. Court needs washed. Wood perimeter around swing set is deteriorating. Sara Maude Mason- boards were powerwashed and are going to put sealant on in February.

There is a chapter in the ordinances called chapter 49, Parks and Recreation. In a twelve month period, three total absences is considered forfeiture of the spot on the board. (Videoconferencing attendance is permissible.) The term of each members appointment on the board is two years.

Need to let the town clerk know about what we want to do with our new applicants and then have the Board approve their applications at the next council meeting.

Sean the financial manager- reviewing the five year comprehensive capital improvement plan: redecking Griffin Park. Replacing the piers along the lake. Should have hand rails on both sides of new piers and some type of path from the sidewalk to the piers themselves. Town is trying to get a grant to help with the basketball court and fence at Central Park. Considering where we could put a pickleball court.

Public safety complex out number two road- new police station and fire station is being built. May also include trails and a park and a footbridge over the wetland area. Suggested a real restroom for Griffin Park now that there is a sewer.

Is there somewhere we could/should put a stage for town events? Can we propose a food truck night where we close down a section of road by the lake and have a festival?

Christmas Events in Howey are this weekend.

People are dumping garbage in Sara Maude Mason Park at night. We need a better gate that locks.

Electronic sign is coming to Howey where the fountain is by town hall.
