BUSINESS IMPACT ESTIMATE – Ordinance 2024-004

- Summary of the ordinance: Pertains to fireworks inside the town limits. Specifies the annual dates and times that fireworks may be used and detonated. Regulates public displays of fireworks, also known as managed displays of pyrotechnics; requires a town permit for such managed displays; requires a town permit and reimbursement of all expenditures the town may incur in the course of permitting a managed display of pyrotechnics.
- **Estimate of compliance costs to town businesses:** None. No town businesses engage in and conduct managed displays of pyrotechnics. Each out-of-town business conducting a display of fireworks must reimburse the town for costs incurred and to be incurred by the town in connection with the managed display of fireworks.
- New charges or fees on town businesses subject to the ordinance: None to town businesses. As to out-of-town businesses, indeterminate. No new fees are being imposed. An out-of-town business engaging in a managed display must reimburse the town for the town's costs. Those costs are not known and likely will vary for each managed display of fireworks.
- **Town's estimated regulatory costs and revenues from new fees and charges:** None. No new fees being charged. Regulatory costs to the town are to be reimbursed in full by businesses engaging in managed displays.
