Statistics for January

The library was open for 25 days in the month of January. Volunteer hours totaled 127.85 hrs. We had 248 patrons used our computers in the month of January. 1598 items were sign out from our library in January. A total of 149 e-books and magazines were checked out in January. The library has a total of 11,357 items. 23 new patrons in January.
