RE: Town Signs

The Parks & Recreation Board recommends that CTI Signs of Astatula be contracted to provide and install gateway and wayfinding signs for the Town of Howey-in-the-Hills. Quotes and renderings are attached.

Note several options on the wayfinding signs that can be discussed at the Council meeting.

For future planning, the Parks & Recreation Board recommends the following phases to implement new Town signage:

Phase 1: Gateway and wayfinding signs per current proposal from CTI, including repainting of current Town Hall and Police Dept. signs to conform to new colors until phase 3 is implemented.

Phase 2: Business wayfinding signage on private or Town property. Cost to be partially underwritten by businesses.

Phase 3: Town parks and public buildings, including a digital message board in front of Town Hall.

Phase 4: Street signs for Palm Avenue with the new color and design scheme.
