 - B. The Mayor Pro Tempore shall receive compensation in the amount of \$300.00 \$125.00 per Town Council meeting, workshop, or specially called meeting attended by the Mayor Pro Tempore. The Mayor Pro Tempore's compensation shall not exceed \$600.00 \$250.00 per calendar month.
 - C. A Town Councilor shall receive compensation in the amount of \$225.00 \$100.00 per town council meeting, workshop, or specially called meeting attended by a Town Councilor. A Town Councilor's compensation shall not exceed \$450.00 \$200.00 per calendar month.
